Conduct Guidelines

When visiting downtown your safety and the safety of others is very important to us. Please use this guide as reference to have a fun and safe visit to downtown Minneapolis.

- Act responsibly
- Be home before curfew
- Don't skip school
- No weapons
- No profanity
- No fighting, yelling or disorderly conduct
- No hanging out at bus stops
- No loitering inside or outside of buildings
- Don't block sidewalks and allow people to pass
- No skateboarding on private property, benches, planters or railings
- No spitting on the sidewalks
- No littering
- No smoking under the age of 18
- No alcohol under the age of 21
